New Series | This Is Love

“God is Love.” This is perhaps the most well-known saying from the letter called 1 John. But what does that look like? The early Christians to whom John was writing were traumatized by division. False teachers denied that God had dwelt among us in the person of Jesus, which also minimized Jesus’ sacrificial death for our sins. People were confused, and opinions were divisive. In response, John emphasized our need for salvation and the guarantee of salvation in Christ. This salvation is not only for life hereafter, but is lived out by a transformed community which embodies God’s love.
