The Greek word doxa means "glory," "honor," or "praise," and it captures the heart of the Reformed vision of worship: God-centered, Word-saturated, Christ-exalting, and Spirit-led.

In this series, we'll explore the theology of worship in the Reformed tradition—not as a relic of the past, but as a living, breathing vision for today's church. We'll trace how *doxa* shapes our liturgy, fuels our singing, grounds our prayers, forms our hearts and sends us into the world with lives that glorify God. This is not simply about what happens in a church service; it's about reorienting all of life to the One who is worthy of all praise.
