Wow, what a week we've had as a church! Well over 2,000 people have come through our doors for the past seven services. Thank you to everyone who helped our guests experience the love of Jesus this Christmas season!

We've been doing Christmas "on location" throughout our advent series attempting to get a glimpse of the reality of this story and better understand how the people within the story experienced the arrival of Jesus. What we've found in this journey together is just how radical and unexpected the events surrounding the incarnation were.

Today, the radical nature of God's revelation continues in perhaps the most unexpected way yet. We all grew up with images of the "Three Wise Men," or, "The Three Kings," or, "The Three Magi." But, have we ever stopped to consider how different these three titles are? Whichever of those three titles we grew up using, it probably shaped the way we perceived these three men and in turn, shaped the way we interpreted the narrative. This morning, we'll visit the Magi on location, and in doing so, find that this story is much more scandalous than many of us may have known. The story of the Magi speaks directly to God's heart for pursuing and including those on the outside.


