December 8, 2019

We are taking a journey to the Holy Land, to the places where the Christmas story actually occurred. Where the story ends will surprise even the most seasoned of believers in our church. Last week we looked at the beginning of Luke's gospel, in Jerusalem where the temple encounter with Zachariah took place. Quickly the scene turns north some 64 miles to the small village of Nazareth. Today Nazareth is a city of 80,000 people, but in the first century it was a village of around 300 people, roughly 30 families. It was a real place, with real people and the encounter between Mary and the Angel Gabriel was real. So much of the historic Advent art and retelling of the story of Jesus is done in a way that is surreal. While beautiful, it also loses some of the normalcy of God's action and activity in the mundane and everyday experience of life, which is how God most often reveals himself. I am excited to share with you the place of the announcement to Mary!

Please make sure to grab a gift tag from the Community Christmas trees in the Lobby this week and help put us over the top to bless families in our community. Last year we blessed over 200 families with gifts and meals for Christmas. And this next week, on Saturday, December 14, we hope to help even more. Your gifts and service at that event are crucial. Also, next week is our very special Christmas worship celebration, "The Sounds of Christmas." We will hold two concerts at our regularly scheduled service times of 9:30 and 11AM.
