

An old friend, Mike Yaconelli, tells a thought-provoking story in his book, *Dangerous Wonder*. When he was six years old, his favorite comic book character was Superman. He admired Superman's strength, colorful uniform, and of course, his ability to fly. Many of Mike's childhood fantasies revolved around flying. He would often sneak into his parent's bathroom and find their forbidden towels (the thick, new ones reserved for guests). Once outside, with the towel tied around his neck and dragging in the dirt behind him, he would run as fast as he could and jump off the highest survivable launching pad he could find. With arms outstretched, cape billowing behind him, wind rushing past his ears, he believed he was flying.

Then came a day when Mike woke up never to wear a cape again. This day came somewhere along the line of "growing up." Somehow, and from somewhere, he had gained the knowledge that flying was nothing more than a childhood fantasy. It was a sad day. Actually being able to fly wasn't the thing that brought him joy, it was the aliveness he felt when he thought he could fly; it was the voice he heard deep inside—a warm and loving voice, a living, believing voice, a wild and dangerous voice. Every time he heard that voice, he knew who it was: God. But that day, when he was just six years young, his God-hearing went bad.

This story is all too familiar for most of us. When we were young we knew how to create space for adventure, being present with friends, and hearing the voice of our Creator as we played, daydreamed, and yes, flew. Unfortunately, "growing up" has robbed us of our childlike wonder, curiosity, playfulness, and passion. We are told—both by others and by ourselves—that we are to leave those ways behind us and get serious. In addition, we are surrounded by technology that we've become addicted to, and it has taken us away from the space we once had to connect with others, ourselves, and God.

Today we'll be talking about reconnecting with that space we once occupied as children. Instead of giving my younger self advice, I'll be seeking advice from my younger self. The self who didn't let the burdens of life overwhelm me, who knew how to stare at the clouds for hours and just wonder about God, and who knew how to just be.


