Dear friends,

Ironically, the last two months of our series on Godspeed seem to have sped by, in spite of our focus on living at a "walking pace" of knowing and being known. Still, I am grateful for the rich conversations this series has generated in our community, small groups, conversations in The Wayside, on staff, and more.

Earlier this week I was doing some work in a local coffee shop during an especially busy time of day. The shop was packed with all kinds of people, including a long line of folks waiting to place their orders. In a flash, a clear thought resounded in my mind: "How in the world are all people going to come to know Jesus?" It seems, at times, to be an impossible mission.

Then I realized everything we've looked at in the Godspeed series points in the direction of mission. Place, Presence, Pace, Identity, Rootedness, and Names — they all inform the meaning and method of being an active part of what God is doing in the world.

Today we'll look at the earliest precursor of "church" in history: the sending of the twelve disciples. What can their assignment teach us about doing God's mission today at Godspeed? I believe that our calling into God's mission is not only possible, but also accessible to each of us, as we are, where we are. I look forward to concluding this series with you and setting the stage for Ash Wednesday on March 6 at 7PM, when we begin the season of Lent and the journey to the cross and resurrection on Easter.
