We've all heard the saying, "the gift that keeps on giving." One of my all-time favorite movie scenes comes from Christmas Vacation when Clark Griswold, surrounded by family, opens his long-awaited bonus check only to realize it's a membership in the jelly of the month club. Leave it to cousin Eddie to state the obvious, "Clark, that's the gift that keeps on giving the whole

What about the opposite: do we have perpetual habits that take, and take, and take from us? The title of today's message is, "The Sin that Keeps on Taking." This week I want to talk about something I wish I had learned earlier in life (and if I'm honest, I still struggle with). It's an area of sin I can safely say everyone one of us commits and yet because of the culture we live in, we have no shame in it. Can you guess what I'm talking about?

I want to brief you on the latest plans regarding the timing for Phase 3 work. The bottom line is that we have decided that most Phase 3 work will be held off until 2020 (probably next summer - after the rainy season).

This is primarily a timing issue. We want to first finish off the sale of the duplexes to help replenish our operating reserves and then convert our current construction loan into a longterm mortgage. This summer and fall were not the right time for us to take on the financial expenditures for Phase 3.

In the meantime, there is prep work to be done. Our three current planning priorities for Phase 3 are to:

- 1. Begin clearing the way for expanding our parking in the lot behind the Safe Haven House by taking down some of the trees there.
- 2. Develop detailed plans so we have an accurate estimate of Phase 3 costs.
- 3. Determine the best way to fund Phase 3 work. It is likely that some additional fundraising will be a part of this.

I want to affirm that we are fully committed to completing Phase 3. As our ministries kick off again this fall, I am reminded and excited about the positive impact our revitalized Wayside and children's spaces are having on so many of our ministries. Thank you for your faithful financial support and personal commitment to impact our world with the love of Christ.
