MAIN PASSAGE

Revelation 3:1-6

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share: Are there discernable times in your Christian walk that you get the sense that you are more spiritually alive? What contributes to these times?
2. Read the description of Jesus in Revelation 3:1. Why do you think He specifically describes Himself as the “He who has the seven Spirits of God” to this church? (cf. Isaiah 11:2)
3. In Isaiah 29:13, God addresses some characteristics of spiritual “deadness.” List the characteristics. How are these characteristics evident in some churches today?
4. Read Titus 3:3-8. How does the indwelling of the Holy Spirit bring life to believers? How does His power in us change the way we live?

FOR REFLECTION

Are any of the characteristics of deadness discussed in Pastor Dale's sermon or this guide true of your life today? If so, confess them and ask God to fill you afresh with the Holy Spirit so that He can wash, regenerate, and renew your heart & life towards Him.
