## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

#### IceBreaker/Getting to know you

1) Jesus is described as the Lion and the Lamb. If you were to symbolically describe yourself as an animal, what animal would it be?

#### **Digging Deeper**

- 2) Read the prophecy in Genesis 49:8-10. What does this prophecy teach us about Jesus' title as "the Lion of the tribe of Judah"?
- 3) Read Deuteronomy 17:14-20. In this passage God gives Israel principles for choosing a king. How do God's principles for choosing a "good king" or leader differ from the qualities that would be sought after in the secular world?
- 4) Read Isaiah 53. The last portion of v.4 suggests that some people misinterpret why Jesus

died. From v.5 and the rest of the chapter what would you say is the reason for the Servant's suffering?

#### Application

5) As you have reviewed and discussed the traits of Jesus as the Lion and the Lamb, what about Him do you admire and want to exercise in your own personal life?

# FOR REFLECTION
