- Waiting on the Lord is meant to train us to be entangled with Him. To exchange, all of Him for all of us.
- Waiting on the Lord was always supposed to be a means to an end... End of self
- Improper waiting trains us in duality and often requires a sign or exterior force.
- 1. His Grace Is Sufficient For You - Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the WORLD! - We thought we were waiting on God but He really was waiting on us.
