Micro-Conclusions

- Are subtle yet fortified expectations along the way to the destination

Repacked Promise: self developed micro conclusions concerning God's plan without His consent. = BIAS

Bias

To incline to one side; to warp; to give a particular direction to the mind; to prejudice; to prepossess

- When you're bias, it's possible that you're on a self-paved road that only leads to your knees.


