MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

- As Christians, we often hear and even share scriptures on God's peace, and we know peace is our portion. But what happens when we don't feel that peace and find ourselves needing more of it?

HOW TO RECEIVE MORE PEACE:

1. Grow in the knowledge of Him - 2 Peter 1:2

- As we grow in the knowledge of God & Jesus through the word/our studies, the things we learn will always point back to God's love for us, which leads us to trust Him more deeply, which births a new level of peace. (Isaiah 26:3)

2. Check your location/attachments:

- If you're missing your peace, analyze what you have been attaching it to. Other people? A desired outcome? Feelings?
- Remember: Our peace will be found and sustained IN Christ alone.

3. "I ALREADY HAVE PEACE & THE AUTHORITY TO DEFEND IT"

- Peace is not something you are trying to earn. It's already been given and made available.
- We position ourselves to guard, protect and defend it.
- Holy Spirit produces, We partner
- Jesus gave, We receive
- We guard & defend

REMEMBER & DECLARE: "NOTHING & NO ONE CAN STEAL MY PEACE!!!" The only way your peace can be taken from you is if you surrender it. (Romans 11:29)
