Lamed - Bet (Reading from right to left)

Lamed: Staff = Authority, Prod, Prick

Bet: House / Tent

The HEART is the inner man, the seat of appetites that is the authorized vessel to prod and prick your house.

IDENTITY VS MATURITY

HEIR / CHILD

Galatians 4:1-2 ESV

4. Submit To Spiritual Leadership

- Spiritual leadership doesn't come before your relationship with God! But if God puts someone in your life to help you grow spiritually, submit to them as they submit to God.

5. Willingly Submit Your Desire
