MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

POINT 1: Establish your baseline

- Where you're internally living from for the day
- Putting your game face on for the day

POINT 2: What are the benefits of living from this base?

- 1. Intuitive Determing Unction
- 2. Spiritual Maturity

POINT 5: Hebrew word "TAMID" - continual, perpetual, always.

POINT 6: It was law to start your morning with a sacrifice.

• What is **YOUR** early? - Set apart time **BEFORE** you have to get ready for the day!

Fire Maintenance During the Day (See graphic)

Fire Maintenance at Night:

- Prime your rest, set your mind, breathe...
- 1. Pray and invite God into your rest
- 2. Think over the day and identify the God moments there will ALWAYS be some. "Do you perceive it?"

Fire Maintenance During the Day...

- Set meditation reminders on your phone
- What are you listening to while driving?
- What are you reading or listening to on your lunch break?
- What company are you keeping?
- How have you programmed your social media algorithm?

• Set your schedule for undistracted, intentional time in your morning (Matt 6:33)

Day:

Keep your daily bread on your mind and mumble...

• Make it relevant to your everday life (Phil 4:8-9)

Night:

Prime your rest...Set your mind...Breathe...
