MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

“The Process” Review:

- God's process requires our participation.
- 2 key parts of the process are #1 The Desire and #2 The Do.

Our surrender starts with a release or letting go. “Father, Your will be done.”

- Your surrender is initiated by that prayer but its not performed by it.
- Surrender is perpetual, not permanent. It's not a one and done thing. Its an intentional, consistent and daily decision, backed with action. (Faith without works is dead)
- The first step to surrender is our denial (refusal) of self.

WHAT COMES AFTER THE PRAYER?

- Your actions, words and response to hardship will be the fruit (external evidence) of your level of surrender (denial, death).
- One of the greatest idols of our time is the idol of SELF - MY preferences, MY intelligence, MY opinion, MY experience, MY feelings, MY desires, what “I” deserve, what “I” earned or worked hard for, MY happiness etc.
- If we're not careful we will start to conduct our lives around those things instead of first consulting God on what our next move should be.
