- **LOOK**: John 5:19 NLT
- **LISTEN**: John 16:13 NLT
- **RESPOND**: 1 Peter 3:15 ESV

MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

- Before we can intentionally put God on display, we have to have an understanding of our identity. **WE ARE SONS OF GOD!!!**
- So how do sons of God put Him on display to the world?
 - STOP**
 - Ask the Father, "God, where are You in this?"
 - Self control and patience are key factors to being able to display God in high pressure moments.
 - LOOK**
 - Once we've stopped, we've positioned ourselves to SEE what/how God sees, and to move as He would move.
 - LISTEN**
 - The Holy Spirit will speak and reveal the truth of every situation and perspective. If you don't stop & look intentionally, you won't be able to hear either.
- **RESPOND**: Once we stop, look and listen, it's on us to respond as a Son should. As THE Son did!
- **BECOME: SEED - ROOT - FRUIT**
 - The goal is to get to a place where we are living in the consistent, manifested fruit of the diligent practice of these simple steps. (**Stop, look & listen**)
 - We want to move from the **seed** being planted, to **roots** taking place deep within our spirits, in Christ.
 - Then our **Response** (the fruit) will always be from the nature of Christ; our **NEW** nature. No more battle of flesh and spirit. We **ARE**, because Christ **IS**!
