MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

- We often talk about God producing His righteousness in us but we don't talk about God producing His hate within us.
- The oil of gladness (Your victory) comes as a result of Christ's love and hate

Iniquity:

- the condition of without law
- contempt and violation of law, iniquity, wickedness
- lawlessness

Why does Jesus hate lawlessness?

- He's a King of a Kingdom!
- Kingdom speaks of Territory
- You are not your own - Your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit!

✓ We're not using our authority against the things God hates

Exousia:

- power of choice, liberty of doing as one pleases

Lack of Godly Hate & Authority:

1. Passivity

acceptance of what happens, without active response or resistance

Resist (Verb)

- to set one's self against, to withstand, resist, oppose
- to set against

2. Tolerant

- showing willingness to allow the existence of opinions or behavior that one does not necessarily agree with.

3. Sight driven

- Sensible
- Down to earth
- Practical
- Pragmatic
- Realistic

The power of sin is unlawful:

Colossians 2:11 MSB

You were in Christ when he died; which means that his death is your true circumcision. This is not hypothetical; this is the real deal. Thus, sin's authority in the human body was stripped of its control over you.
