PRACTICE THE PRESENT OF GOD

Believers holy acts

- prayer
- fasting
- surrender
- worship—yet function with minimal evidence of divine power
- much activity, little supernatural manifestation.

Output = Effort Outflow = Nature

Fatigue can begin to frame faith

From an act to a state

From Practice to Personification

- Driving, Typing, Walking while talking, Reading, Playing an instrument
 - Each starts with conscious repetition and ends in embodiment

God didn't send a bunch of Acts. There's a book of Acts, but what preceded the Acts was the word made flesh — incarnated Word.

Theme	Old Testament (Concept)	New Testament (Incarnation)
Dwelling	Temple made with hands — God among His	Temple of the Holy Spirit — God within His
Law	Law written on stone — external command.	Law written on hearts — internal transformation;
Word	The Word of the Lord appeared — revelation	The Word made flesh — revelation embodied.

PRACTICE THE PRESENT OF GOD

MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

God Sending People solving problems He could trust:

When famine hit, He raised Joseph.

Tried: to smelt, refine, test - extract (metal) from its <u>ore</u> by a process involving heating and <u>melting</u>.

- When empire oppressed, He sent Moses.
- When corruption ruled, He anointed prophets.
- · When sin & sickness reigned, Grace became flesh.
- · Divinity chose embodiment as its delivery system.
- · God's partnership isn't performance-based; it's incarnation.

The Two Models:

Category	Participating (the act)	Remaining (the state)
Nature	Volitional movement of the will toward God.	Ontological condition of being in God.
Posture	Verb — I open, I yield, I dance.	Noun — I am open, I am yielded, I am in Him.

PRAYER:

Aspect	Act of Prayer	State of Prayer
Definition	Intentional communication with God—speech, petition, or silence.	Continuous communion —life lived in unbroken awareness and cooperation with the
Example	"Lord, teach us to pray." (Luke 11:1) — Jesus went up to the mountain to pray. (Luke 6:12)	"Father, You always hear Me." (John 11:42) — <i>Pray</i> without ceasing. (1 Thessalonians 5:17)
Essence	Encounter — meeting God through dialogue.	Indwelling — God breathing and responding through you.

If you equate act with state, you keep returning to the act to feel connected—mistaking moments of communication for the reality of communion.

MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

WORSHIP:

Aspect	Act of Worship	State of Worship
Definition	Intentional expression of reverence / surrender—voice, posture, offering.	Continuous surrender— existence aligned with divine will.
Example	"They bowed down and worshiped Him." (Matthew 28:9) — "Our fathers worshiped on this mountain" (John 4:20)	"Present your bodies a living sacrifice." (Romans 12:1) — "True worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth." (John 4:23)
Essence	Encounter — meeting God through expression.	Embodiment — God revealed through being.

If you equate act with state, you keep returning to the act to feel connected—mistaking moments of communication for the reality of communion.

MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

The Deception Within The Acts

Acts can cripple fullness:

- It trains dependence on felt engagement.
- · It binds peace to performance cycles.
- It treats the rehearsal (devotional act) as the event (union).
- It subtly implies separation that must be bridged again and again.

If practice becomes the pinnacle, your devotion becomes deception.

Self-reliant spirituality.

Why? Unity is perceived as a goal — not a current reality.

The Deliverance

We are not rejecting the acts, we are repurposing them

Exercised:

Indicates a completed action with continuing results. Faculties that now operate by reflex, not rehearsal.

So the training occurred in the past and its effects persist in the present.

PRACTICE THE PRESENT OF GOD

MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

Full age...

Maturity = the state produced by prior disciplined practice:

- Continual practice (devotional exercise) yields an abiding state (discernment by nature).
- The training phase concludes as a process, but its result—the ability to discern—is permanent.

Led: existence under divine propulsion.

The Spirit isn't giving directions to sons; He is the momentum within them. It's not a momentary act of obedience but an ongoing condition of animation.

Sonship ceases practice. Sonship seizes perfection. Habit Vs Habitation

Acts belong to training your belief — you're training for reigning. The Deliverance

Belief =

- I AND MY FATHER ARE ONE
- I REST

MAIN POINTS, DEFINITIONS & APPLICATION

Faith trains reality - it takes your unseen inner state and calibrates what you see.

You live and walk by faith, not by sight. Faith changes sight, not the other way around.

In Christ Confessions:

- I am not maintaining connection; I am communion itself.
- I am not trying to believe; belief has become my nature.
- I am already what obedience was training me to become.
- I am what devotion was hoping to reach.
- I am the dwelling my prayer once sought to enter.
- I am the rest my labor longed to find.
- I am the fruit that discipline was bound to bear.
- I embody what all creation groaned for
- I am the evidence that grace succeeded.
- I personify the Father's intent on earth.
- I am communion embodied
- I am fellowship embodied
- I am hope fulfilled
- I am what faith saw

THEME	OLD TESTAMENT (CONCEPT)	NEW TESTAMENT (INCARNATION)
DWELLING	TEMPLE MADE WITH HANDS — GOD AMONG HIS PEOPLE.	TEMPLE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT — GOD WITHIN HIS PEOPLE.
LAW	LAW WRITTEN ON STONE — EXTERNAL COMMAND.	LAW WRITTEN ON HEARTS — INTERNAL TRANSFORMATION; LIVING EPISTLES.
WORD	THE WORD OF THE LORD APPEARED — REVELATION FROM OUTSIDE.	THE WORD MADE FLESH — REVELATION EMBODIED.

THE ACT VS THE STATE:

CATEGORY	THE ACT	THE STATE
NATURE	VOLITIONAL MOVEMENT OF THE WILL TOWARD GOD.	ONTOLOGICAL CONDITION OF BEING IN GOD.
POSTURE	VERB — I OPEN, I YIELD, I DANCE. (PARTICIPATOR)	NOUN — I AM OPEN, I AM YIELDED, I AM IN HIM. (PARTAKER)

PRAYER

ASPECT	ACT OF PRAYER	STATE OF PRAYER
DEFINITION	INTENTIONAL COMMUNICATION WITH GOD	CONTINUOUS COMMUNION
EXAMPLE	"LORD, TEACH US TO PRAY." (LUKE 11:1) — JESUS WENT UP TO THE MOUNTAIN TO PRAY. (LUKE 6:12)	"FATHER, YOU ALWAYS HEAR ME." (JOHN 11:42) — PRAY WITHOUT CEASING. (1 THESSALONIANS 5:17)
ESSENCE	ENCOUNTER	INDWELLING

WORSHIP

ASPECT	ACT OF WORSHIP	STATE OF WORSHIP
DEFINITION	INTENTIONAL EXPRESSION OF REVERENCE & SURRENDER	I AM SURRENDERED
EXAMPLE	"THEY BOWED DOWN AND WORSHIPED HIM." (MATTHEW 28:9) — "OUR FATHERS WORSHIPED ON THIS MOUNTAIN" (JOHN 4:20)	"LIVING SACRIFICE." (ROMANS 12:1) — "IN SPIRIT AND IN TRUTH." (JOHN 4:23)
ESSENCE	ENCOUNTER — MEETING GOD THROUGH EXPRESSION.	EMBODIMENT — GOD REVEALED THROUGH BEING.

WHEN ACTS DECEIVE

• IT TRAINS DEPENDENCE ON FELT ENGAGEMENT

• IT BINDS PEACE TO PERFORMANCE CYCLES.

• IT TREATS THE REHEARSAL (DEVOTIONAL ACT) AS THE EVENT (UNION).

• IT SUBTLY IMPLIES SEPARATION THAT MUST BE BRIDGED AGAIN AND AGAIN.

INDICATES A COMPLETED ACTION WITH CONTINUING RESULTS. FACULTIES THAT NOW OPERATE BY REFLEX. NOT REHEARSAL.
