- Assume the position of brokenness
- Engage In meaningful Conversations
- Elevate Purpose Over Position

Never allow your position to distract you from your purpose

Esther's preparation was not only spiritual, it was also physical

Inductive Bible Study Method 1 Peter 2: 9 **Observation** (What does Dav What I learned (observation / interpretation): the text say?) This phase is about observing How I will Respond (application): exactly what the text is saying. Pretend you're an investigator who's just gathering the facts. Ask yourself the five W's and H: (Who, what, where, when, why, how). Acts 13: 36 F What I learned: Interpretation (What does the text mean? How I will Respond: Discover what the author is trying to communicate. And to do this, you need to look at the context to determine What is the main theme and what is the **meaning** of key **Job 42: 1 – 2** What I learned: words; Examine cross references Compare translations How I will Respond: Summarize the text Use commentaries (last resort) Application (How 6 should this affect Me?) Isaiah 46 10 – 11 What I learned: **F** Don't study the bible just for knowledge - study for application. If you stop at the interpretation How I will Respond: stage, you are selling yourself short. Based on what you have learnt, ask yourself "How should this change the way I think, speak and behave? **Exodus 9: 16** What I learned: Seek to identify if there are - Sins F. to confess; Promises to claim; Examples to follow; Actions to obey or Knowledge to grow in.
