Out of the Wilderness Season



Up until this point, the Israelites have experienced heartaches, death, votes of no-confidence in God their king, plagues, and despair. They have also experienced God's provision and hope, but those moments were overshadowed by their rebellion and wickedness against God.

Joshua 1:1-9

After the death of Moses the servant of the Lord, the Lord said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. No one will be able to stand against you all the

days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. **Be strong and courageous**, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.

"Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."

and reveal his splendor and glory; God is going to call you to show others what HE is like. — Pastor Perry

This will not be easy.

We see stories every month it seems of some massive icon of Christianity being taken down by sexual scandal or some other abuse.

Somewhere somehow, they turned to the left or to the right from God's Law.

This hurts God's image.

This hurts God's church.

This hurts God's people.

God takes this very seriously. It's not just for Christian leaders to not turn to the left or to the right, **but for each and every one of us**, because each one of us represents, speaks for God's people and God himself. We are accountable to God and the Church for how we reveal Jesus to the world. What you do matters — whether good and for evil.

Pastor Perry & Danielle have committed to living what we preach. There is full transparency across our elders, phones, computers and everything else.

Our pastors and our staff team is deeply committed to holiness and to Christ.

We want you to make the same commitment — men and women. Because we as a people are commanded not to turn to the left or to the right from the Law of God.

If you are stuck in shame or bondage, we commit to each other not to shame you or condemn you but conquer the evil one in your life.

Be careful not to turn to the left or to the right. — YHWH

YHWH Cares
