First 3¹/₂ years of the 7-year tribulation period

- 1. Begins with the unveiling of the antichrist
- 2. The 144,000 are sealed
- 3. The two witnesses will come unto the scene at the beginning of the tribulation
- 4. In the beginning, Israel will be allowed to rebuild the temple
- 5. There will be wars and rumors of war
- 6. There will be famine and plagues
- 7. Believers will be martyred for their faith
- 8. People will die from wars, famines and diseases

2nd 3¹/₂ years of the 7-year tribulation period

- 1. Antichrist is possessed by satan at the beginning of this time. People will be told to worship him as god
- 2. 144,000 are still evangelizing the world
- 3. The two witnesses are killed and are raised after 3 days
- 4. Still wars and rumors of wars
- 5. Still famines and plagues
- 6. $1/3^{rd}$ of the earth, trees and grass are burned up
 - $1/3^{\mbox{\scriptsize rd}}$ of sea life dies and $1/3^{\mbox{\scriptsize rd}}$ of ships are destroyed

 $1/3^{\mbox{\scriptsize rd}}$ of drinking water becomes undrinkable

1/3rd of each day no light

- Demonic scorpions sting people who suffer for 5 months, will want to die, but can't
- 8. Demonic army comes forth

 $1/3^{rd}$ of mankind is killed
