Helping others see Jesus

A. Live in such away that you reflect His glory

1. Wrapped in a cloud – God’s presence
 - a. We have to accept by faith that Hs is with us even though it may not feel like it.
 - 1) What does that do for us?
 - 2) How does that help others see Jesus?
2. Rainbow over his head – God’s faithfulness
 - a. What do rainbows remind us of?
 - b. How does this help us in our everyday lives?
 - c. How can this help others see Jesus?
3. Face was like the sun – God’s glory
 - a. Why did Moses’ face to glow or radiate?
 - b. In what ways can we reflect Jesus’s glory?
4. Legs like pillars of fire – God’s justice
 - a. Fire can be symbolic of judgment and cleansing
 - b. The tribulation period is in part about what?
 - c. How do our lives reflect the cleansing work of God in our lives?

B. Let the Spirit of God work through the word of God

1. The scroll, whatever it contains, is the word of God
 - a. Why might have John been told to eat the scroll?
2. What is necessary for the word of God to impact our lives?

- a. What happens when the word of God impacts our lives?
 - b. How does that help others see Jesus?
3. How can the word of God be both bitter and sweet?
 - a. When is it most likely that the word of God will taste sweet to us?
 - b. When is it most likely that the word of God will taste bitter to us?

C. Make sure your words and actions align with one another.

1. Why was John told not to measure the outer court (the court of the Gentiles)?
 - a. What does vs. 1 & 2 indicate will happen in the tribulation period?
 - b. What is 1,260 days in months (vs. 2)?
2. The ministry of the two witnesses take place when?
 - a. Which verses in chapter 11 indicate this?
3. What signs will the two witnesses perform during the 1st 3 ½ years?
4. Some possibilities as to who the two witnesses are
 - a. Enoch and Elijah – why them?
 - b. Moses and Elijah – why them?
5. What is the purpose of the two witnesses?
6. How did the signs they performed align with what they proclaimed?

First 3½ years of the 7-year tribulation period

1. Begins with the unveiling of the antichrist
2. The 144,000 are sealed
3. The two witnesses will come unto the scene at the beginning of the tribulation
4. In the beginning, Israel will be allowed to rebuild the temple
5. There will be wars and rumors of war
6. There will be famine and plagues
7. Believers will be martyred for their faith
8. People will die from wars, famines and diseases

2nd 3½ years of the 7-year tribulation period

1. Antichrist is possessed by satan at the beginning of this time. People will be told to worship him as god
2. 144,000 are still evangelizing the world
3. The two witnesses are killed and are raised after 3 days
4. Still wars and rumors of wars
5. Still famines and plagues
6. 1/3rd of the earth, trees and grass are burned up
1/3rd of sea life dies and 1/3rd of ships are destroyed
1/3rd of drinking water becomes undrinkable
1/3rd of each day no light
7. Demonic scorpions sting people who suffer for 5 months, will want to die, but can't
8. Demonic army comes forth
1/3rd of mankind is killed
