D. It is easier to walk together when we focus on what we have in common (4:4-6)

E. It is easier to walk together when we seek to grow together. (4:7-16)

1. We should seek to grow together in:
 - a. unity in faith, growth in knowing Jesus and growth in our spiritual maturity
2. If we are to walk together, we must accept what?
3. Why is growing together important to our walking together?
