- A. As Israel stepped onto the other side of the Jordan, it was a willing testimony of their willingness to challenge their faith. To believe in what they could not see.
- B. It was the day they put God's words to the test: Joshua 1.5: *I will be with you, ...I will not leave you or abandon you. Be* **strong** and courageous. Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go, Joshua 1.5, 9.
- C. Our best days aren't in the past ... our best days are ahead.
