

Episode 24 — The Surpassing Worth of Knowing Christ

Text: Philippians 3:8–11 (CSB)

Episode Summary:

In this episode, Paul moves beyond rejecting confidence in religious credentials and reveals what truly defines his life—knowing Christ. Philippians 3:8–11 captures Paul’s conviction that everything else fades in comparison to the surpassing value of being found in Christ and receiving righteousness through faith. This episode invites listeners to reconsider what they count as gain and to rediscover the freedom and hope that come from treasuring Christ above all.

Key Themes:

- The surpassing value of knowing Christ
- Righteousness received, not earned
- Identity rooted in Christ
- Resurrection hope shaping present faith

Key Scripture:

“I also consider everything to be a loss in view of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord.” — Philippians 3:8 (CSB)

Takeaway Truth:

When Christ becomes our greatest treasure, everything else finds its proper place and lasting peace becomes possible.

For Application:

Reflect on what may be competing with Christ for first place in your heart. In prayer, ask God to deepen your desire to know Him and to root your confidence fully in Christ.

Series Focus:

This episode continues Philippians 3 by shifting from discarded credentials to treasured relationship, preparing the way for Paul’s call to press forward toward the ultimate goal in Christ.
