



Episode 6 — *Living with a Settled Purpose*

Text: Philippians 1:20–21 (CSB)

Episode Summary:

In this episode, we turn to one of the clearest purpose statements in all of Scripture. Writing from prison and facing an uncertain future, Paul expresses a settled confidence rooted not in outcomes, but in Christ. Philippians 1:20–21 shows us how a Christ-centered purpose brings stability, courage, and peace—even in the face of loss or uncertainty. This episode encourages listeners to begin the week with clarity about what truly defines life and meaning.

Key Themes:

- A Christ-centered purpose
- Stability in uncertain circumstances
- Freedom from fear of outcomes
- Courage rooted in devotion to Christ

Key Scripture:

“For me, to live is Christ, and to die is gain.” — Philippians 1:21 (CSB)

Takeaway Truth:

When Christ is the center of life, circumstances no longer control our peace or identity.

For Application:

Take time today to honestly reflect on what you are living for. In prayer, re-center your heart on Christ as the foundation of your purpose and ask for courage to live with that clarity.
