- 2. What can we learn from Elijah's experiences in Cherith and Zarephath about dependence on God during challenging times? How does God use difficulties to prepare us for His purpose?
- 3. What significance did Mount Carmel hold in the contest between God and Baal? How did Elijah's unwavering faith in God lead to the people's repentance and return to God?
- 4. How does Elijah's challenge to Israel resonate with our own need for decisiveness in following God? What worldly distractions do we need to leave behind to wholeheartedly commit to Him?
- 5. *Living Out Our Faith:* What actions and behaviors exemplified Elijah's faith? How can we ensure that our faith is not merely words but is demonstrated through our actions and obedience?

Group Activities

1 Kings 18.21

21 Then Elijah approached all the people and said, "How long will you waver between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow him. But if Baal, follow him." But the people didn't answer him a word.

- 1. *Elijah's Wilderness Experience:* Divide into small groups and discuss a personal experience where you felt God was preparing you during a challenging time. Share how it strengthened your faith.
- 2. *Mount Carmel Revisited:* Discuss Elijah's encounter with the prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel. Talk about the significance of God's response and the people's repentance. How can we apply this lesson to our lives today?
- 3. *Making Decisive Choices:* In pairs, identify areas in your life where you need to make more decisive choices in your commitment to God. Share your goals and support each other in taking action.
- 4. *Living Out Your Faith:* Share personal examples of how your faith has been demonstrated through your actions. Discuss how faith and works are interconnected in your daily life.
