#3 vs 1-2 An exact dating of Luke's accounts (both Roman and Jewish) why both?

vs 3-14 John begins his preaching - what is the message?

How would the people show their acceptance of his message?

- the common man?
- The tax collectors?
- The soldiers?

How do we show our acceptance of our own need to repent?

vs 15-16 What was the question in people's mind re' who John really was?

vs 19-20 What were the consequences of his preaching?

- for the people
- For John

vs 21-22 Jesus is baptized – what took place? What did God have to say about it?

... How does that apply to us today?

Vs 24-38 Luke gives a very complete lineage of Jesus. (ancestry.luke) Why the detail?
And why all the way back to Adam?

#4 covers

the Temptations – Acceptance – Rejections – Miracles – and early Ministry of Jesus:

vs 1-2 Jesus takes on Satan for 40 days – He does not eat during that time: Your thoughts on why this is mentioned?

Vs 3-13 Jesus is tempted with three specific temptations:
What are the three and what do they represent?

Your thoughts as to why He was able to overcome the temptations?

What was Jesus' price?

What is **YOUR** price? What is **MY** price?

14-15 Jesus preaches in Galilee and is accepted

16-30 Jesus preaches in Nazareth and is rejected
(who rejected Him and why?)

31-37 Jesus does miracles in Capernaum of Galilee

38-39 Jesus heals Simon's mother-in-law

40-44 Jesus preaches and ministers throughout Galilee
