

## Episode 39 — Jesus Purifies Our Conscience

Lord's Supper Meditation

Text: Hebrews 9:13–14 (CSB)

Episode Summary:

In this week's Lord's Supper meditation, we reflect on the cleansing power of Christ's sacrifice. Hebrews 9:13–14 contrasts the temporary sacrifices of the Old Covenant with the perfect offering of Jesus. While animal sacrifices could address outward ceremonial impurity, the blood of Christ accomplishes something far greater—it cleanses the conscience. Through His sacrifice, Jesus removes guilt and frees us to serve the living God with renewed hearts.

Key Themes:

- The superiority of Christ's sacrifice
- Cleansing of the conscience
- Freedom from guilt through the blood of Jesus
- Serving God with a purified heart

Key Scripture:

“How much more will the blood of Christ... cleanse our consciences from dead works so that we can serve the living God.” — Hebrews 9:14 (CSB)

Takeaway Truth:

The sacrifice of Jesus does more than address sin externally—it cleanses the conscience and frees us to live in devoted service to God.

For Application:

As you prepare to partake of the Lord's Supper, reflect on the cleansing power of Christ's blood. Thank Him for removing guilt and ask Him to help you serve the living God with a renewed heart.
