

Episode 31 — Stand Firm in the Lord

Text: Philippians 4:1 (CSB)

Episode Summary:

As Philippians 4 opens, Paul calls believers to steady perseverance rooted in Christ. After reminding the church of their heavenly citizenship and eternal hope, he urges them to “stand firm in the Lord.” This episode explores what it means to remain anchored in faith when pressures rise and discouragement threatens stability. Standing firm is not about stubbornness or self-reliance—it is about being rooted in Christ and strengthened by faithful community.
