What was causing the religious leaders of the day to “NOT” embrace the teachings of Jesus? .... What would be their cost if they did?

So they look for things He is saying or doing to “discredit” Him and His works.

So what is the problem with doing miracles on the Sabbath? (BCV)

God had specified His reasons for His people not working on the Sabbath. Yet the Jewish leaders had creatively come up with ways to get around their own Sabbath day laws. (exp a Sabbath day journey)

**YES** - we are not under the Old Law today. Your thoughts about still having a need to rest and remember our Creator... Or why the need to do away with the “blue laws” of generations past? (alcohol sales, sporting events, gambling, retail sales, hunting, et al )

.... All 100 years before prohibition... prohibited on Sundays up until 1966 =1<sup>st</sup> to repeal ... N. Dekota 1991 the last to concede commerce allowed back on Sundays.

**YES** – instead of the Sabbath, We observe “the Lords Day”  
Or is it “the Lord’s Morning” ?  
Or is it “the Lord’s 3 hrs” ?
