
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Shavuot שַּׁבְעוֹת



- Shavuot: Shav (7), Shevua 🛂 📮 is Weeks (plural)
- English: Feast of Weeks
- Greek: Pentecost (50)
- Feast of harvest and Day of Firstfruits (Num 28:26) more than 1 first fruit days
- Chag (3 pilgrimage feasts)
- שְׁבוּעְה oath
- What is Unique?

Let my people go!



Why?

- Ex 3:18 sacrifice, 7:16 to serve me
- Exo 5:1 ...Let My people go, so that they hold a festival to Me in the wilderness

The purpose of leaving Egypt is to serve Yahweh and keep the Festival of Shavuot – so Passover is the first step to get you to Shavuot

...But Shavuot doesn't have a date, except the way you count is anchored in Passover

Learning to do what?

- Gen 5:24 And Enoch <u>walked</u> with Elohim. Then he was no more, for Elohim took him.
- **Gen 6:9** This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, perfect in his generations. Noah <u>walked</u> with Elohim.
- **Gen 17:1** And it came to be when Abram was ninety-nine years old, that appeared to Abram and said to him, "I am Él Shaddai walk before Me and be perfect.
- Mar 10:15 Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the reign of Elohim as a little child, shall certainly not enter into it.



<u>Life:</u> Chai = choose life, Eternal life.

Joh 6:40 And this is the desire of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him should possess everlasting life. And I shall raise him up in the last day.

Deu 30:19 "I have called the heavens and the earth as witnesses today against you: I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. Therefore, you shall choose life, so that you live, both you and your seed, to love אוני your Elohim, to obey His voice, and to cling to Him – for He is your life and the length of your days – to dwell in the land which אוני swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them."

Choose Life: Trust in Yah, take the Passover, and Obey His Voice



<u>Liberty</u>: D'ror = freedom. What is freedom? Knowing the Truth - not being deceived

Joh 8:31 So אור said to those Jews who believed Him, "If <u>you stay in My Word,</u> you are truly My taught ones, and you shall know the truth, and the <u>truth shall make you free</u>."

Gen 4:7 If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin crouches at the door; and its desire *is* for you, but you shall rule over it.

Psa 119:151 You are near, הוה, And all Your commands are truth.

Staying in His Word will reveal the Truth, and make you free



<u>Liberty</u>: D'ror = freedom. What is freedom? Serving Yahweh is Freedom

Deu 5:15 And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and that יהוה your Elohim brought you out from there by a strong hand and by an outstretched arm. Therefore, יהוה your Elohim commanded you to perform the Sabbath day.

Psa 119:44 So shall I observe your law continually for ever and ever; And I will walk at ease (freely), for I have sought Thy precepts

1Pe 2:16 ..and not having your freedom as a cover for evil, but as servants of Elohim.

Shabbat is an Act of Freedom – only slaves don't keep it Servants of Yahweh are Free



Happiness: Asher = "straightness"
Doing it right/walking straight gives happiness

- *Opposite: Avon (crookedness)*
- Similar but different: Baruch (blessed...)

Psa 1:1 Happy is the man who shall not walk in the counsel of the wrong, And shall not stand in the path of sinners, And shall not sit in the seat of scoffers, but his delight is in the Torah of הלוה, And he meditates in His Torah day and night. For he shall be as a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That yields its fruit in its season, And whose leaf does not wither, And whatever he does prospers.

Psa 119:1 Happy are the perfect in the way, Who walk in the Torah of הוה

Happiness is how you live your life Happiness is under your control

How should we speak?

<u>1Pe 4:11</u> If anyone speaks, let it be as the Words of Elohim.

How/what should we think?

Jos 1:8 Do not let this Book of the Torah depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate on it day and night, so that you guard to do according to all that is written in it. For then you shall make your way prosperous, and act wisely.

<u>Php 4:8</u> For the rest, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is righteous, whatever is clean, whatever is lovely, whatever is of good report, if there is any uprightness and if there is any praise – think on these.

Where do we start?

<u>Joh 5:46</u> For if you believed Moses, you would have believed Me, since he wrote about Me. But if you do not believe his writings, how shall you believe My words?

Is this for me?

Num 15:29 For him who does whatever by mistake there is one Torah, both for him who is native among the children of Israel and for the stranger who sojourns in their midst. But the being who does whatever defiantly, whether he is native or a stranger, he reviles הלוה, and that being shall be cut off from among his people. Because he has despised the word of הלוה, and has broken His command, that being shall certainly be cut off, his crookedness is upon him

Rev 22:14 Blessed are those doing His commands, so that the authority shall be theirs unto the tree of life, and to enter through the gates into the city.
