BASELINE QUESTIONS:

- 1) "Are there people you know who attracted to the same sex?"
- 2) Do you think your environment (school) is accepting of same sex-relationships? Why or why not?
- 3) Do you think that people are born homosexual? Why?

READ TOGETHER:

1) Genesis 1:27-28

What is the significance of God creating humanity with a male and female and not any other way?

- The way in which woman was created indicates she is the man's divinely designed compliment
- The nature of one-flesh union presupposes two persons of the opposite sex
- Only two persons of the opposite sex can fulfill the procreative purposes of marriage
