Jesus never asked anyone to

- Get their act together before following Him
- Fix all their past mistakes before following Him
- Get a theological degree from a seminary before following Him
- Unjack up their jacked up life before following Him

How Jacked Up were the 12 disciples?

1. They were full of **pride**

“After they arrived at Capernaum and settled in a house, Jesus asked his disciples, “What were you discussing out on the road?”³⁴ But they didn’t answer, because they had been arguing about which of them was the greatest.” Mark 9:33-34

2. They were **overconfident**

“Peter declared, “Even if everyone else deserts you, I will never desert you.” Matthew 26:33

3. They were **wimpy**

“At that point, all the disciples deserted him and fled.” Matthew 26:56

4. They were slow to **understand** Jesus’ teachings.

“Those who heard Jesus use this illustration didn’t understand what he meant.” John 10:6

“But they didn’t know what he meant. Its significance was hidden from them, so they couldn’t understand it, and they were afraid to ask him about it.” Luke 9:45

5. They were **vengeful**

“He sent messengers ahead to a Samaritan village to prepare for his arrival. But the people of the village did not welcome Jesus because he was on his way to Jerusalem. When James and John saw this, they said to Jesus, “Lord, should we call down fire from heaven to burn them up?” Luke 9:52-54

“One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers—Simon, also called Peter, and Andrew—throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living.¹⁹ Jesus called out to them, “Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!”²⁰ And they left their nets at once and followed him.²¹ A little farther up the shore he saw two other brothers, James and John, sitting in a boat

with their father, Zebedee, repairing their nets. And he called them to come, too. ²² They immediately followed him, leaving the boat and their father behind.” Matthew 4:18-22

HOW TO REBUILD YOUR JACKED UP LIFE

1. **Recognize** that Jesus is calling you to **follow** Him

“One day as Jesus was walking along the shore of the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers—Simon, also called Peter, and Andrew—throwing a net into the water, for they fished for a living. ¹⁹ Jesus called out to them, “Come, follow me, and I will show you how to fish for people!” Matthew 4:18-19

2. **Seize** the moment

“The opportunity of a lifetime must be seized within the lifetime of the opportunity.” Leonard Ravenhill.

“And they left their nets at once and followed him.” Matthew 4:20

3. **Identify** the jacked-up **areas** of your life that need to change

“As Jesus was walking along, he saw a man named Matthew sitting at his tax collector’s booth. “Follow me and be my disciple,” Jesus said to him. So Matthew got up and followed him.” Matthew 9:9

4. **Refuse** to allow anyone or anything to prevent you from **rebuilding**

“A little farther up the shore he saw two other brothers, James and John, sitting in a boat with their father, Zebedee, repairing their nets. And he called them to come, too. They immediately followed him, leaving the boat and their father behind.” Matthew 4:21-22
