CAUSES OF FINANCIAL DISASTERS

Lack of a <u>Plan</u>

"But don't begin until you count the cost. For who would begin construction of a building without first calculating the cost to see if there is enough money to finish it? ²⁹ Otherwise, you might complete only the foundation before running out of money, and then everyone would laugh at you" Luke 14:28-29

<u>Impulsive</u> Buying

The Baby Steps to Financial Peace

- 1. Emergency Fund of \$1,000
- 2. Pay off debt using the debt-snowball method
- 3. Emergency Fund of 3 6 months of basic living expenses
- 4. Save for retirement 15% of your pay
- 5. College Savings for kids
- 6. Pay off your home mortgage
- 7. Live and Give like no one else
