1. Hope that brings *Freedom*

2. Hope to Help

"For surely it is not angels he helps, but Abraham's descendants." Hebrews 2:16

3. Hope of Forgiveness

"For this reason he had to be made like them, fully human in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in service to God, and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people." Hebrews 2:17

Atonement = making amends or reparation for guilt or wrongdoing

"But he has appeared once for all at the culmination of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of himself. ²⁷ Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment, ²⁸ so Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many; and he will appear a second time, not to bear sin, but to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him." Hebrews 9:26-28

4. Hope in **Temptation**
