10. When being our kid’s **friend** became more important than **disciplining** them

9. When spending **money** became more important than spending **time**

*“Then he said, “Beware! Guard against every kind of greed. Life is not measured by how much you own.” Luke 12:15*

8. When **recreation** became more important than **responsibility**

*“She goes to inspect a field and buys it; with her earnings she plants a vineyard. She is energetic and strong, a hard worker. She makes sure her dealings are profitable; her lamp burns late into the night.” Proverbs 31:16-18*

7. When tough times led to **division** rather than **unity**

*“Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy. For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow.” James 1:2-3*

6. When your family stopped **laughing** together

*“A cheerful heart is good medicine.” Proverbs 17:22*

5. When **disrespect** replaced **kindness** and **courtesy**

*“Instead, be kind to each other, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, just as God through Christ has forgiven you.” Ephesians 4:32*

4. When **selfishness** and **pride** went unchecked

*“Pride goes before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall.” Proverbs 16:18*

3. When we became **apathetic** about serious family issues
