Personal Revival Comes Through the Comforter

"And I will ask the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may be with you forever; the Spirit of Truth, Whom the world cannot receive because it does not see Him or know Him. But you know Him. For He dwells with you and shall be in you." John 14:16-17
