Relationship Builder #1: Aim High with LOVE

Five ways to aim high with my love:

1. Without love all that I say is ineffective

"If I speak in the tongues of men or of angels, but do not have love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal." I Corinthians 13:1

2. Without love all that I *know* is *incomplete*

"If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:2

3. Without love all that I *believe* is *insufficient*

"and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:2 "The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love." Galatians 5:6

4. Without love all that I give is insignificant

"If I give all I possess to the poor...but do not have love, I gain nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:3

5. Without love all I *accomplish* in *inadequate*

"If I give over my body to hardship that I may boast, but do not have love, I gain nothing." 1 Corinthians 13:3

Relationships Rebuilder #2: Speak the truth

Tell the truth...

1. Consistently

"Reliable communication permits progress." Proverbs 13:17

2. Completely

"Someone who holds back the truth causes trouble." Proverbs 10:10

"In the end people appreciate frankness more than flattery." Proverbs 28:23

3. Lovingly

"speaking the truth in love." Ephesians 4:15

4. Tactfully

"Thoughtless words can wound as deeply as any sword. Wisely spoken words can heal." Proverbs 12:18

"if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another." 1 John 1:7

"Most of all, let love guide your life." Colossians 3:14

"Love is patient, love is kind.
