



THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

John 16:1-15

1. He will Convict the world

- Of Sin – because they do not Jesus (vs8 &9)
- Of Righteousness (vs 8 &10)
- Of Judgement (Vs 8 & 11)

2. He will Guide you (vs 13)

- Into all the truth
- Truth based on Divine Authority (John 16:13 & John 14:10)

3. He will Glorify me (vs 15)

- Jesus is the one that is glorified
- Glorify – Taking what is Jesus and declaring it

4. He will Declare it to you (vs 14 & 15)

- **Formal with Authority:** Not a casual statement - The Holy Spirit's declaration about Christ carries divine authority and truth.
- **Very Explicit:** Very precise - When we read the Scriptures, or when the Spirit illuminates our hearts, He "declares" truth in an unambiguous way.

4. He will Declare it to you (vs 14 & 15)

- **Assertion:** A declaration asserts something as true, valid, or intended - The Holy Spirit's declaration is an assertion of divine truth.
- **To be made known:** to some intended audience - The Holy Spirit's declaration is a revealing act to those who believe.
