EVANGELISM how do I share my faith?

phase one - DIAGNOSIS

This offends the self-righteousness. You communicate the need for a cure for the sickness. Diagnosis reveals and addresses a problem

phase two - PRESENTATION OF THE CULTURE

Give hope to those who already know they are sinners

phase three - RESPONSE

Challenge all to come to the cross – come to Jesus

Different Kinds of Evangelism:

Confrontational evangelism
Relational evangelism
Organizational evangelism
Supernatural evangelism

- If there is no such thing as sin, there would be no need for a Savior – no need for the cross
- We have to find our own efforts to meet the standard that God has set for the world
- We must understand that the Bible declares that there are certain things that are just wrong
- Society progressively becomes more violent, more agitated by the truth of the Gospel

- The longer someone is in darkness the more irritated he/she becomes when you shine the light
- When shining the light we must remember that we need to communicate the truth about sin

EVANGELISM IS:

- Sharing Christ whenever you can, where you are, with whoever you are with
- Always turning to the question: "But what about Jesus?
- The measure of how great of a threat your faith is to Satan's kingdom
- Realizing you may be the first or last Christian between anyone and hell fire

EVANGELISM IS:

- The executioner of the self-life, the labor room of the new birth, and the incubator of the new creation, and the midwife that births the saints
- Seeking out the lost sheep, not expecting them to find the Shepherd
- Obeying Jesus Christ's commandment to every Believer to "go out into the hedges and highways, and compel lost souls to come in"
