| 4.  | Choose to i others into the fight with you.  Isolation leads to defeat every single time!  Not everyone is on the front lines, but <u>EVERYONE</u> is to be engaged in the fight somehow.                              |
| 5.  | Choose to remember only through Jesus, we experience spiritual v (vv.15-16  • We have a greater mediator interceding for us. (Heb. 7:25; Rom 8: 34)  |
