Gen. 12: 1-4; Gen. 15: 1-6; Gen. 17: 1-8; Gen. 21: 1-5; Gen. 50: 19-21

Abraham > Issac > Jacob (God changes his name to Israel) > 12 Sons (one of them is named Joseph) > Joseph is sold into slavery > Joseph is unjustly thrown in prison > He interprets dreams by God's power in prison > Pharaoh is having dreams that no one can interpret and God gives Joseph wisdom to tell Pharaoh meaning (that there is going to be a famine in the land) > Pharaoh puts Joseph over everything in Egypt > The famine forced Joseph's brothers to come to Egypt looking for food > They eventually are reunited, including Jacob and Joseph > After Jacob dies, Joseph's brothers feared that Joseph would pay them back for selling him into slavery. God turns evil for His good and glory.
