<p>Amillennialism</p>	<p>There will be no literal historical reign of Christ on earth for 1,000 years. His second coming ushers in the eternal state.</p>	<p>The kingdom reign of Christ &amp; His saints exists for the period between Christ's two comings.</p> <p>Promises to Israel about a land, seed, and throne are completely fulfilled now in a spiritual sense in the church.</p> <p>Christ is ruling now; Satan is bound between the Christ's two comings.</p>	<p>Origen, Augustine, John Wycliffe, Martin Luther, John Calvin, B.B.
