



Intro: Announce Vision Night Feb.5th.

From day one, will we seek THE ONE, and reach the one?

Luke 10:1-3 “After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. 2 Then He said to them, “The harvest truly *is* great, but the laborers *are* few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. 3 Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves.””

Vs 1. “The Lord Appointed 70 others also”...the nameless, faceless, faithful that God still appointed and anointed.

They were “appointed”

They were anointed (Vs.9 & 19) he didn't send them out unequipped. He anointed them with the appointment and reaffirmed it in vs. 19.

He will not ask you to do what he has not empowered you to do!

- **Pray and Go!**

We are called, appointed and anointed to be a people of prayer. Prayer keeps us connected to Him. Prayer is where he reveals His will and prayer is where He conforms our heart and will to His. Prayer is where our spirit is strengthened and our body and soul are brought into submission.

Jesus set the example for us to be a people of prayer. He repeatedly withdrew from the masses, withdrew from the ministry to go pray and commune with the Father. So must we!

“Not my will but yours be done.”

“Could you not watch and pray.”

“This kind comes out only through prayer and fasting.”

1. As you go...go in the authority and power of the Spirit! vs. 1

He gave us his Word with an appointment and an anointing. Fully EXPECT God to do not only what he said he would do (come to the cities they were sent to)

He has promised that He will do:

“Exceedingly and abundantly above all we can ask or even imagine.”do

He said we would do: The works that he did and greater works than these also!”

When you go in the appointment and anointing of His Spirit you go in His power and authority. Expect God to show up. Expect GREAT things!

2. Remember who sent you and walk-in that commission. Vs. 3

Go with confidence rooted in the Lord. “God has not given you a spirit of fear, but of power love and a sound mind.” Go in that power. Go in that love. Go in that confidence that is rooted in a sound mind.”

“HE keeps in perfect peace the mind that is stayed upon him, because he trusts in Him.”

3. Remember your identity. Walk-in it. Don't confirm to the pattern of the world. Vs. 3

4. Be aware of your surroundings but not fearful of them. Vs. 3

Luke 10:4-12 “4 Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road. 5 But whatever house you enter, first say, ‘Peace to this house.’ 6 And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. 7 And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house. 8 Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. 9 And heal the sick there, and say to them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near to you.’ 10 But whatever city you enter, and they do not receive you, go out into its streets and say, 11 ‘The very dust of your city which clings to us we wipe off against you. Nevertheless know this, that the kingdom of God has come near you.’ 12 But I say to you that it will be more tolerable in that Day for Sodom than for that city.”

5. Go in faith and trust (leave your purse behind) Vs. 4

“My God shall supply for all your needs according to His riches in glory.”

He is the God who “sees ahead and makes provision!” He is Jehovah Jirah

We walk by faith not by sight.

Jesus had just gotten done teaching the need to count the cost and leave all behind if we are to follow him. Now he calls them to put it into action.

6. Go with discernment (be attuned to God's voice and will. There are people He has prepared to receive Him) Vs.5-6

He is the Spirit of Wisdom and Discernment. Walk therefore in the Spirit. Let him direct your steps. Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He shall direct your steps.”

7. Go with contentment Vs. 7-8

Godliness with contentment is great gain. Don't fall into the trap of comparison. Don't look for greener grass. Water the lawn where he calls and opens the doors for you!
