Title Slide: <u>Hope in God</u>

Intro:

Slide #1 Mk 1:15 "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!"

Slide #2 Matt 7:24 "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock. ²⁵ And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock.

Slide#2: Matt 28:18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Slide#3 Mark 12:29 "The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.^[2] ³⁰ Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.

Slide#4 ^{Jn} **14:7** If you really know me, you will know^[a] my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him."

Slide#5: Jn14:⁹ Jesus answered: "Don't you know me, Philip, even after I have been among you such a long time? Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?

Slide#6: In **5:19** Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does.

Slide#7: Gal4:⁶ Because you are his sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba,^[a] Father."

Slide#8: Ro8:32He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

Slide#9: Ro8:31What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us.
