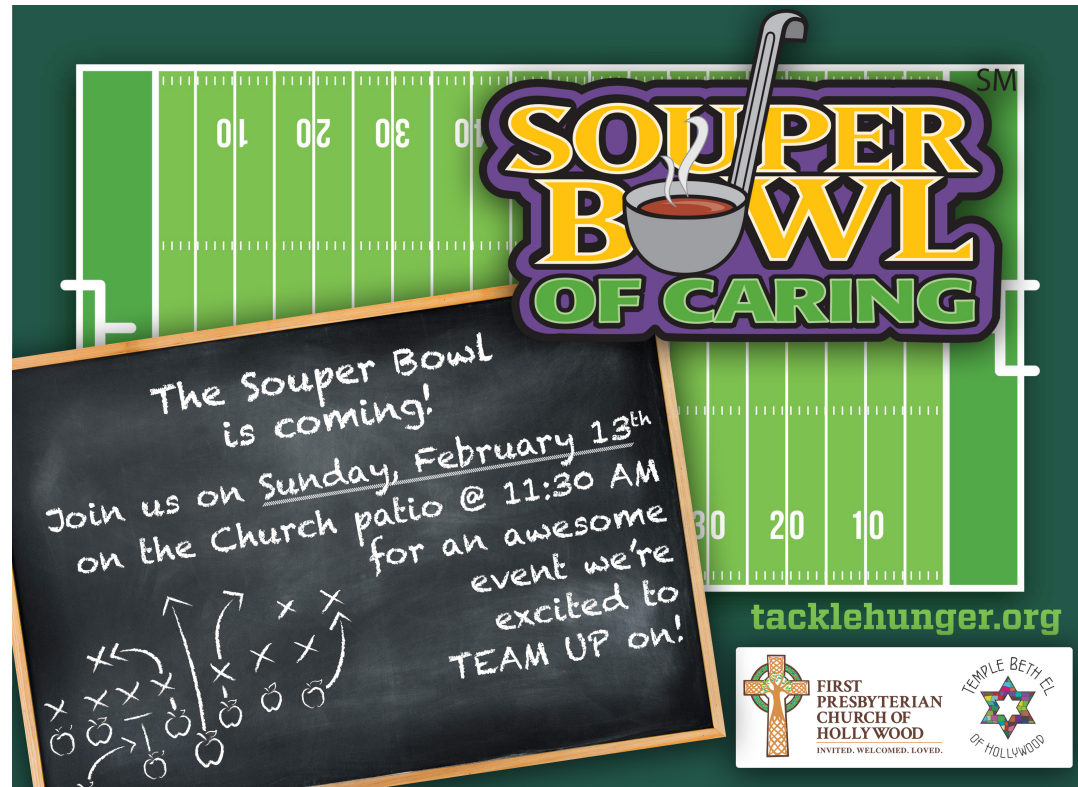

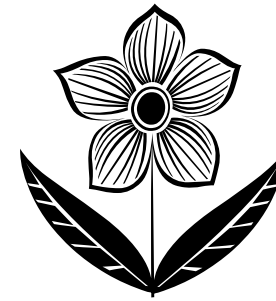


Join us and Bold Justice for a Wine and Cheese Gathering
