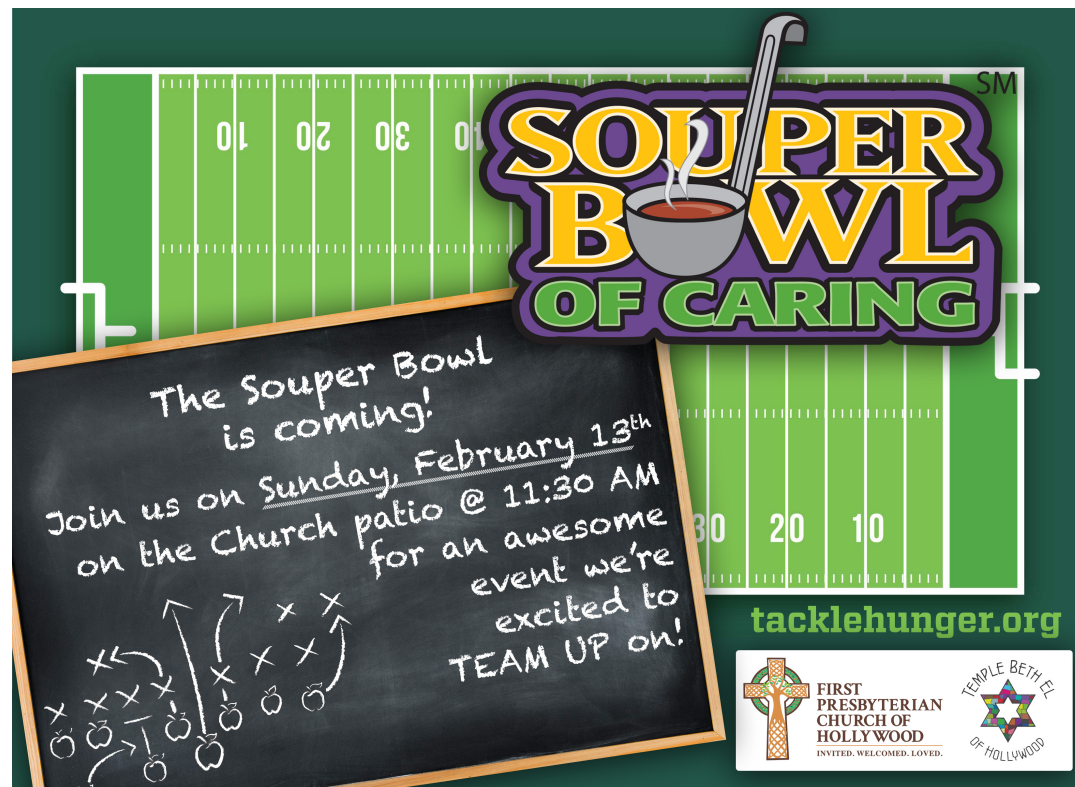

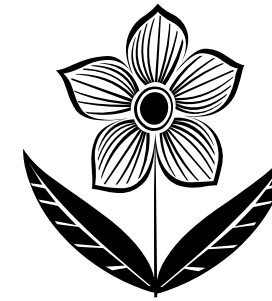


Join us and Bold Justice for a Wine and Cheese Gathering on the Church patio on February 12th from 6 to 7:30 PM.
