We have the 4 volunteers identified for the final house painting on Aug 8.

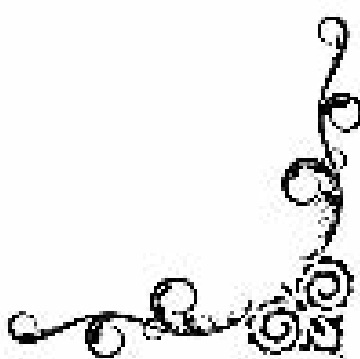
Blessing of the Backpacks and School Supplies August 16

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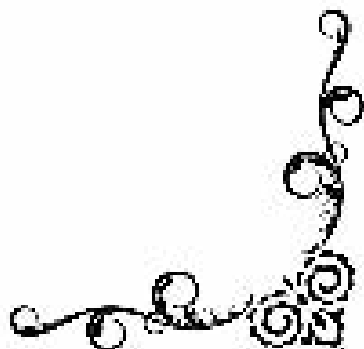

SCRIPTURE READING

Psalm 32 (NRSV version)

**Happy are those whose transgression is forgiven,
whose sin is covered. Happy are those to whom the
LORD imputes no iniquity and in whose spirit there is
no deceit. While I kept silent, my body wasted away
through my groaning all day long. For day and night
your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was
dried up as by the heat of summer. Selah Then I
acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not hide my
iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the
LORD," and you forgave the guilt of my sin. Selah
Therefore let all who are faithful offer prayer to you;
at a time of distress, the rush of mighty waters

shout for joy, all you upright in heart.**

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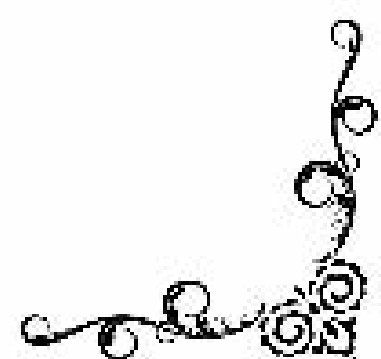
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
