What Kind of God? - "God is Gracious"

MESSAGE NOTES:

John 8:2-11

² At dawn he appeared again in the temple courts, where all the people gathered around him, and he sat down to teach them. ³ The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group ⁴ and said to Jesus, "Teacher, this woman was caught in the act of adultery. ⁵ In the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women. Now what do you say?" ⁶ They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing him.

But Jesus bent down and started to write on the ground with his finger. ⁷When they kept on questioning him, he straightened up and said to them, "Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." ⁸Again he stooped down and wrote on the ground.

⁹ At this, those who heard began to go away one at a time, the older ones first, until only Jesus was left, with the woman still standing there. ¹⁰ Jesus straightened up and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?"

¹¹ "No one, sir," she said.

STEP THREE: Discuss Questions

- 1. What was challenging, encouraging, confusing, or stood out most to you from this past weekend's teaching?
- 2. Many people don't believe in or are disappointed in God because He doesn't meet certain expectations they have for Him. Can you share a time when this was true for you?
- 3. God's grace is His undeserved blessing, favor, or kindness. **Read Psalm 145:8-9**. What are some ways that God shows his common grace to all people, including those who don't believe in Him?
- 4. **Read Romans 2:4**. Why is God ultimately gracious and kind?
- 5. Can you share a time when you specifically, or our culture in general, has taken advantage of or made a mockery of the kindness of God?
- 6. Why is the kindness of God ultimately only accessed through Jesus Christ? With what posture, and how does one receive this kindness?
- 7. What is a next practical step God is calling you to do as a result of considering His kindness, and who is one person that God may be calling you to share this kindness with this week?
